### About the district

The Garaway Local School District consists of approximately 1,180 students. Buildings include Baltic Elementary, Dundee Elementary, Miller Ave. Elementary, Ragersville Elementary, and Garaway 7-12 as well as a community center building housing concessions, locker rooms, and space for professional development.

The district has been rated "Excellent" for eight consecutive years. Our strong academic program is carefully balanced with arts and athletics. Four of our six buildings have wireless technology, Garaway 7-12 is utilizing 1:1 Initiative with the use of Chromebooks. All grade levels will be transitioned to the Common Core this year.
