Dear Lockland Local School District Residents:

The Ohio Department of Education recently released the 2017-18 State Report Cards for all schools and districts in Ohio. Lockland Schools has shown significant growth and improvement in several areas.

Compared to 2017, Lockland Local School District's:

- Pass rates INCREASED in 15 of 21 areas
- English scores INCREASED in 7 of the 8 tested grade levels in grades 3-11.
- Pass rates in 6 of the 8 English tests INCREASED with double-digit gains.
- Pass rates INCREASED in all tested areas (English, Math, Social Studies and Science) for high school.
- High school English test pass rates **INCREASED** by more than 15%.
- High school Math test pass rates INCREASED by more than 10%.
- High school Government pass rates INCREASED by more than 15%.
- High school Biology pass rates INCREASED by more than 25%.

While there is much to celebrate on the State Report Card, we still have a number of challenges to overcome in other areas measured. We are confident that our continued efforts will result in increased levels of performance each year.
