The Search

The Midview Board of Education is seeking qualified applicants for the position of treasurer. The search is due to the resignation of Nikki Spriggs who served as treasurer for the past five-and-a-half years. Mr. Greg Ring, Superintendent of the Lorain County Educational Service Center, will be assisting the Midview Board of Education with its search.

About the District

The Midview Local School District currently operates five instructional buildings and a transportation/maintenance facility. The Midview North, Midview West, and Midview East buildings were constructed in 2005 and Midview Middle School was constructed in 2012. The high school was built in 1967.

Our district begins preparing students for college and careers as young as kindergarten. The district provides a variety of academic pathways to meet the needs of all students and to prepare them for life after they leave Midview.

Project Lead the Way (PLTW) provides hands-on learning experiences to K-12 students. Through an engaging, participation-based classroom environment, PLTW empowers students to develop the knowledge and skills they will need to be successful in their futures. Lessons are focused on engaging students through hands-on activities, projects, and problems, helping them to learn to think critically, solve real-world challenges and reimagine the world around them.

Midview High School is the first in Lorain County to develop a unique partnership with Lorain County Community College and Hyland Software Inc. to provide a CCP Information Technology course in which 40 percent of the course will be at Hyland Software's Westlake headquarters.

In addition to the normal college preparatory classes, Midview offers honors and Advanced Placement courses along with My University, Engineering courses, Biomedical Sciences, Gateway to Technology, and Project Launch.



About the Community

The Midview Community consists of Eaton Township, Grafton Township, Grafton Village and Carlisle Township along with a small portion of Elyria. Midview is one of the largest geographic school districts in Lorain County covering 68 square miles comprising a mixture of suburban, rural, and village communities.

The Midview District is located approximately 30 miles from Cleveland, Ohio with access to some of the country's most prestigious cultural and medical centers, popular professional sports events and impressive parks and recreation facilities.
