

THE COMMUNITY

The Osnaburg Local School District consists of about 35 square miles in east central Stark County. The district, with a population of 5,886, includes the Village of East Canton and most of Osnaburg Township, as well as a small portion of Canton Township. Osnaburg Local is the smallest public school district in Stark County with an ADM of about 875 students. The area has some light industry but is basically a rural area. The preK-12 students are served in one new facility which opened in September 2010. The district allows open enrollment from the five contiguous school districts.

The village provides fire and police services to the school and village. The township is served by the East Canton Fire Department and the Stark County Sheriff's Department. Many community and school activities are held at The Foltz Community Center on Wood Street. At this time, Route 30 runs directly through the village, but plans have been developed to expand the expressway from Trump Road to an on-ramp south of the village. Community support of the school has been very good and attendance at school athletic contests and musical events has been great.

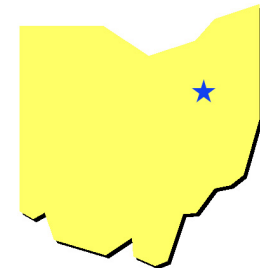
